Pastor's Page

The New Church Year – December brings us to the Season of Advent and a new Church year. The Season of Advent is filled with

the prophecies of Isaiah –

- Who reminds us we are clay, the God as our potter. God, shaping our lives
- Who offers comfort to God's people, and declares that God's Word lasts forever.
- Who reminds us that the Lord loves justice, hates wrongdoing, yet chooses to cloth us in "garments of salvation."

These passages of Isaiah will be the focus of our Wednesday Advent services at 7:00 p.m. the first three Wednesdays of December. Join in Advent Worship services at Zion, Grace and St. James on December 6, Grace 13 and 20, as a means of making time to listen for a different voice during the "Holidays" (Holy Days!); the voice of God which offers a different way of looking at the days leading to Christmas. Christmas Eve – Every few years, the Season of Advent is a bit more compressed, and December 24th falls on a Sunday as the Fourth Sunday in Advent. We will have worship Sunday morning at 10:00 a.m. and celebrate the 4th Sunday of Advent, and then at 5:00 p.m. in the afternoon, we will share in our traditional Christmas Eve worship with the building of the crèche, family readings of the Christmas Story in Luke's gospel, and many opportunities to sing and give thanks to God for sending Jesus, the Son into the world to save us from sin and death!

"A Season of Giving" – This time of year is often called just that, "A Season of Giving."

- Grace once again has its Giving Tree to offer families and children in this area gifts during the Christmas Season.
- Waynesboro Area Refuge Ministry (WARM) Cold Weather Shelter will be serving the Homeless in December as we host the Cold Weather Shelter at Grace. See the article elsewhere in this newsletter how you can help.

- HERO of Waynesboro, a new organization designed to help keep families and individuals from becoming homeless by keeping people facing eviction or losing their utilities safely in their homes, had a great informational meeting on Tuesday, November 14th at First Baptist. The group is working to become a 501c3, and is being helped by the Community Foundation to get on its feet, and to begin its mission more quickly by serving as a sponsor, and offering a \$15,000 matching grant to get up and running! “A Season of Receiving” – At the same time, in a Season where we are encouraged to exhaust ourselves with the expectations of all we are encouraged to “do,” STOP. Put the Cell Phone, the Tablet, the Laptop down, the car keys in their resting place. Pick up a Bible. Read it aloud, find someone else to read it with. Read Isaiah 64:1-9 the first week of December, Isaiah 40:1-11 the second week of December, Isaiah 61:1-4, and 8-11 the third week of December. Read Mark 1:1-8. Read Luke chapters 1 and 2, Read Matthew chapter 1. Then John 1. All told it will take MAYBE 30 minutes of your time. Don’t do it all at once. Again, read it aloud, let those words roll over you. Read them with your spouse, or a good friend. Read them with your children, or grandchildren, or favorite nieces, nephews or beloved neighborhood kids, whether they are 3 or 13 or 23 or 43. Let the intentions and actions of our Gracious God echo in your ears, in your hearts. Receive the Good News! Receive the truth that God loves you and this world so much. We need that simple

truth during “the Holiday Season.” We need it far beyond these next few weeks, in the world we live in!

Advent/Christmas at

The Season of Advent - Yes, soon, a New Church Year, and the Season of Advent will be upon us! We celebrate the Season once again with a series of Wednesday Advent Services with a focus on the prophecies of Isaiah as they point us toward our salvation through the Messiah, Jesus Christ. Plan to join in worship with our Lutheran sisters and brothers in Christ this Advent!

Outdoor Christmas Wreath Assembly - *We will assemble the Advent Wreath that gives witness to our community that we are looking for Jesus the Messiah in the days leading to Christmas on Wednesday, November 29.*

Wednesdays in Advent - *Evening Prayer and reflection on the theme: Our Salvation Through the Messiah, Jesus Christ. We share these worship services with our Lutheran brothers and sisters in the Waynesboro area:*

- **Wednesday, December 6th** – at Zion Lutheran Church at 7:00 p.m.
- **Wednesday, December 13th** – at Grace Lutheran Church at 7:00 p.m.
- **Wednesday, December 20th** – at St. James Lutheran Church at 7:00 p.m.
- **Thursday, December 21** - at Bethlehem Lutheran Church with Blue Christmas emphasis at 7:00 p.m.

Christmas Decorating! - *This annual Sunday activity transforms our worship space in preparation for Christmas Eve and will take place Sunday, **December 17th**; we'll finalize time and details.*

Christmas Eve - December 24th, 10:00 a.m.

Christmas Eve - December 24th, 5:00 p.m. - *Our children and adult choir will present a wonderful program of music and assist in the telling of the Good News of Jesus' birth, as families "build" the manger scene. We will celebrate Holy Communion and sing Silent Night by candlelight.*



December 4 - 11 WARM-Grace Cold Weather Shelter (CWS)

On Monday - December 4, we begin hosting the CWS here at Grace - **Please** keep our guests, this ministry and our volunteers in your prayers throughout the week! We are looking forward to a week of hard work and many blessings as we welcome our homeless neighbors into our church home for warmth, fellowship, food and shelter - we want to offer safety and stability for the week.

If you are interested in volunteering or have questions, please call/text Susan Myers at 434-760-1660 as soon as possible! We always have room for more volunteers.

Interacting with guests is an important part of our hospitality - common sense, consistency, trust, patience and understanding are all important. **Most important** - please bring your ears - being a good listener is often the most important thing we can do to help our guests!

Some general tips:

- Be polite and respectful to everyone, demonstrate polite behavior
- Do not touch a guest unless you ask permission first (May I hug you?)
- Wear a nametag, call guests by name as you learn
- Do not give out personal information (phone #, address)
- Listen, listen, listen - and ask questions; or silently be present with a guest.
- **Do not** allow guests into the church outside CWS hours (6:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m.).
- **No photos, no use of guests' names** on social media or outside conversations.
- **All volunteers must sign the Confidentiality Agreement**

Remember: **CALMS**

- **Connect** - wear a name tag, ask the guests for their name and try using their name when conversing.
- **Assess** - how is our guest? Empathize with their situation - ask how are you? how was your day? were you able to stay warm today? would you like some water ... or a snack? We will have Drink/Snack Tables set up.
- **Listen** - listen and repeat information back to the guest to let them know you hear them; engage in "active listening" - it's okay to ask questions, if they're upset - is there an underlying issue?
- **Maintain Safety** - at all times! If a guest is venting - stay leg-length away; set boundaries physically and emotionally (put your hands up, back away, explain "you are making me uncomfortable"). *** If you do not feel safe for any reason, notify our Evening Coordinator Donna Yobs and get assistance. ***
- **Support** - Listen, allow the guest to vent. Demonstrate empathy - try to understand their frustration, anger and/or sadness. Their situation/issue is not "mine." Seek to understand; remember that it is not our job to fix their situation.

We had two wonderful weeks last season - guests commented "You **want** us here," and "I felt so welcome." We are looking forward to opening our doors and anticipating blessing both FOR our guests and FROM our guests! **Thanks be to God!**
